LAWO staff and volunteer attorneys will provide information and advice on civil matters to eligible residents of Shelby County through the use of computers and video conferencing services on issues that include:

- » Debt collection / creditor harassment
- » Car repossession
- » Rent escrow / conditions issues in private housing (no bed bug cases)
- » Early lease termination in private housing
- » Return of security deposit in private housing
- » Family law
- » Garnishment

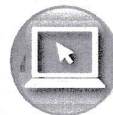

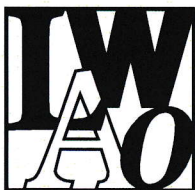
